SCHOLARSHIPS AND FREESHIPS POLICY

1. Policy Statement:

In order to promote an outstanding academic performance, excellence in research, social service, games and sports, cultural activities, participation in students counseling, constructive leadership and overall performance, the **East West Institute of Technology** may award various scholarships, prizes, medals and awards either from its own funds or from funds obtained from other governmental or non-governmental sources.

2. Objectives:

In order to financially assist (a) meritorious students coming from weaker economic background, (b) girl students and (c) Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST) and Other Backward Caste (OBC) students, the Institute may award

- (i) Scholarships,
- (ii) Tuition Fee Waivers (Free-ships),
- (iii) Book and other Grants,

3. FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM INSTITUTE FUNDS

In order to financially assist meritorious students coming from economically weaker background, the Institute may award scholarships to needy students from its own funds made available for this purpose.

Submission of Applications for the Award of Scholarship

- On the commencement of each academic year, the students will submit applications for the award of Scholarships of all years.
- Income affidavit for the year proceeding the year of application, of the scholarship shall be submitted by the parent/guardian of the applicant along with completed application for Government scholarships.

SC ST Book Bank

A book bank is established in the library to cater SC/ST students. The Book Bank is a separate section in a library, where text book, reference books and other miscellaneous books can be reserved for these special categories of users. Main aim of setting up Book Bank is to encourage the category students by providing informational and educational assistance from the institute itself.

• Best student award:

The Institute gives Best student award certificate to the 1st Topper of each discipline.

• Other scholarships, prizes and medals

Rotary Scholarship will be given as per the norms set by the Rotary Club, the donor agency.

. The Institute welcomes starting of new scholarships, prizes and medals for its undergraduate as well as postgraduate students from other governmental and non- governmental sources. However, the purpose of instituting new scholarships, prizes and medals should fulfill the goals for the same.

For any new award at the Institute level, it is required to get approval from management. Terms and conditions for the award of a new scholarship/prize/medal in the Institute shall be formulated by the management. No obligation is to be normally prescribed for awarding any scholarship/prize/medal.

General guidelines

- All scholarships, medals, etc. are liable to forfeiture/withdrawal partially or fully in case
 of misconduct or deliberate concealment of material facts by the award winner. A similar
 action may also be taken if it is found that a student has deliberately misguided the
 institution in this regard.
- A student leaving the Institute on his/her own accord without completing the prescribed program of study may be required to refund the amount of scholarship received by him/her in that academic year.

• The mangement is empowered to change the clauses of scholarship by giving an advanced notice to this effect to its members.
